1. Completed application form
2. Two written character references
3. Photo or scanned copy of your firearms licence
4. Photo or scanned copy of your driver’s licence
5. Photo or scanned copy of proof of citizenship
6. NSWAPA transfer form from your current club to SIPC, or a letter of transfer from another club

The membership officer will contact you to arrange an interview. These interviews take place at the Club on Saturdays at a pre-arranged time. You will be shown around the club facilities, and the Membership Officer will answer any questions you may have. At the interview, you are required to produce the originals of Items 3, 4, and 5 above.

Should you wish to proceed, you must pass a safety and proficiency test with a rimfire pistol under the supervision of the club captain and pay a non-refundable application fee.
